

Board members present: Don Davis, Chuck Riley, Doug Abel, Mark Olsen, Eric Armstrong, Vic Lerum, Brandon Liesemeyer

6:30 - Role Call. Motion to approve previous meeting minutes approved.

Don Davis recognized and welcomed Brandon Liesemeyer as a new Board Member.

6:32 – Treasury report by Doug Abel: \$465.00 income and \$6,705.17 in expenses. Balance: \$54,025.79.

6:35 – Fight Training by Mark Olsen. Training season is completed. 106 pilots, including repeats. 60 individuals. Averaged over 10 per week. Five instructors with a bit of help from Chris Avelino and Dave Bracci. 2 people have joined the club, with indications that 4-8 more will be joining. Only lost two airplanes this year, which is an improvement. Would like to see two more instructors who want to help on Mondays.

6:40 – Safety Officer briefing by Mark Olsen: Nothing noted for safety in the last month.

6:41 – Chuck Riley discussed Valley Center shades. Shade structures are up at the VC site. Thanks to the volunteers who showed up to help - structures look great! Tables are next!

6:45 – Don Davis: Jim Christy provided economic data relating to membership loss when we move to VC. If the club had a 50% membership loss, it would still be operational.

7:48 – Eric Armstrong provided a waste management update. We have our green waste waiver approved and documented from the County. The board voted 7-2 to replace the dumpster with a 95-gallon bin. Eric provided his recommendation on how to best deal with the recycling and green waste billing from Fallbrook Waste since 2022 and 2023.

6:55 – Don Davis discussed flight restrictions at both fields. 700 feet AGL at Johnson Field and 1,200 feet AGL at VC. Brandon suggested we have signs made for each field. There was no motion to vote, but the idea will be carried forward.

7:01: Don Davis discussed the concept of creating a visitor's pass that would cost \$15 to \$40, depending on how much time the pilot needs. The pass is intended for AMA-registered pilots visiting our area for a limited time who wish to use our facility on more than one occasion.

Motion to adopt creating a visitor's pass with a review in 6 months: Chuck Riley

Vote passed 7-0 in favor

7:18 – Don Davis: Organization chair for Elections will be Jim Christy. Organization chair for the Auction (end of October) is still open. Organization chair for the Christmas party will be Don Davis.

7:23 – Eric asked Don to announce the club's battery policy again during the club meeting on Saturday. The policy is that under no circumstances are batteries allowed to be left at either field.

7:25 – Don and Doug brought our extra porta-potty to the VC site. Switching the servicing of all porta-potties at both sites to every other week will save the club approximately \$50 per month.

7:30 - Board meeting adjourned.











One of the best flying planes is the T-28 Trojan built by North American. It makes almost any pilot look good!






